Although we too have had to adapt to the covid-19 restrictions (onsite prison ministry has been discontinued and volunteers are prohibited from entering the facility) we implemented an aggressive plan to contact chaplains assisting them with the on-going ministry of our Correspondence Bible Study and Fresh Start training curriculum which can be facilitated inside the prisons by the Chaplains or their inmate trustees.


Please pray with us:

2Tim 2:2 And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.






The dank dismal walls of his prison cell were to be his home for at least the next 50 years of his life. Hope seemed as unobtainable as having a cool breeze blow through the thick windowless concrete. Adam could not see a future much less a purpose for his life. He had lost everyone and everything that mattered.

Adam received eternal life while in that same prison and began to worship and participate in the chapel services. It is there that he first heard of EE-Fresh Start. After being trained in our program, Adam's life took on a new meaning and God began preparing him for his calling. He was asked to become the first inmate facilitator of the course and was appointed as one of the Chaplain's trustees. For over 15 years, Adam trained and mentored countless men in EE (many who have since been released and not returned to prison!)

Adam was miraculously released after 21 years and reunited with a daughter that grew up during his incarceration. Adam is now married to his beautiful wife, Ingrid, graduated with a seminary degree, pastors a church in Port St. Lucie, FL and co-hosts a Christian radio talk show. We have recently welcomed Adam on board with EE Prison Ministry as Independent Field Worker (IFW). We are so excited to have him on the team! All thanks to a God Who gives Fresh Starts!
